The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of certain real estate situated in Frederick and Carroll Counties State of Maryland, of which George Gore of Frederick County Maryland died seized and possessed, and for distribution of the proceeds of said sale among the heirs at law, and those entitled thereto according to their just proportions.

The Bill states that a certain George Gore of Frederick County Maryland in the month of December in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty one departed this life at the County aforesaid intestate seized and possessed of certain real estate, consisting of a farm containing two hundred and forty four and one eighth acres of land more or less, lying partly in Frederick and partly in Carroll Counties Maryland, about eighty acres of which lies in Frederick County and the remainder
