 the return of the Sheriff of Frederick County certifying its due execution and the finding of the Jury

 ing of the Jury that the said Jacob F. Baer is so far deprived of his reason and understanding  
 that he is unfit and unable to take care of his person or manage his estate. It is therefore this  
 sixteenth day of February A.D. 1883 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court  
 of Equity that the said Inquisition and the return thereof be and the same is hereby ratified and  
 confirmed and that Anna V. Baer of Frederick County be and she is hereby appointed trustee  
 or Committer to take charge and custody of the person and estate of the said Jacob F. Baer, and it  
 is further ordered that before the said Anna V. Baer proceeds to act as such trustee or Committer  
 of the said Jacob F. Baer she execute a bond to the State of Maryland with good and sufficient  
 security to be approved by the Court or Clerk of this Court in the penalty of Fifteen hundred dol-  
 lars conditioned that the said Anna V. Baer as trustee aforesaid will faithfully discharge her  
 duties as trustee of the said Jacob F. Baer and deliver up the property of the said Jacob F. Baer  
 whenever she may be required by the order of the Court and to render an account of all her ac-  
 cepts in every two years or oftener if required and to return an inventory of all property and  
 funds she as such trustee may receive belonging to the estate of the said Jacob F. Baer.
