At the request of William Hill the following Deed was recorded August 28<sup>th</sup> 1867 Slough 570  
May 25<sup>th</sup> 1867  
This Deed, made this twenty fifth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty seven, by me, Jacob Nusbaum, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars, I the said Jacob Nusbaum do grant unto William Hill all the following described parcel of land lying in Frederick County Maryland, being part of a tract of land called called Warfield's Inheritance and contained within the following limits and bounds Viz:  
Beginning at a stone now planted in the old Buffalo road and at the end of fifteen perches on the twentyeth line of the deed from Joshua Warfield to Jacob Nusbaum bearing date the ninth day of June Eighteen hundred and forty nine, and running thence with and bounding on said line allowing three degrees for octograde variation and extending further, North forty seven degrees West twenty one perches to a stone now planted in the New Buffalo road, then along and in said road, South forty degrees West twenty perches to a stone planted in said road, then by lines of division, South forty seven degrees East nineteen perches to a stone planted in the Old Buffalo road, then along and in said road North forty six degrees East twenty perches to the place of beginning. Containing and now laid out for two and a half acres of land according to the Certificate of survey thereof, bearing the twenty fourth day of May Eighteen hundred and sixty seven.
