4th Inter

Was William Hill indebted to the Complainant at the time of his death, and if yes, for what amount and has said indebtedness been paid?

4th Ans. He was indebted to David E. Stern, the Complainant, at the time of his death amounting to Twenty one dollar and ninety two cents (\$21⁹²/₁₀₀) This indebtedness has not been paid.

5th Inter

Look at Exhibit Number 1. now shown you, and state whether or not you saw said William Hill make his mark thereto, and whether or not the same was given for said indebtedness to the Complainant? State all you know with reference thereto.

5th Ans. The witness here looked at Exhibit Number 1. and said, she cannot read or write the paper Exhibit No. 1. was then read to her by solicitor for the Complainant, and she said that she did not see William Hill make his mark to it, but William Hill her husband told her in the month of February Eighteen hundred and Eighty two (1882), that he had given his note to David E. Stern, at that time for the sum of Twenty one dollar and ninety two cents (\$21⁹²/₁₀₀)

6th Inter

Did said William Hill die, seized and possessed of any real estate? and if yes describe the same, state its value, location and quantity. Look at Exhibits 4-5 and 6. now shown you and state whether or not the Real Estate therein described is that of which said William Hill died, seized and possessed?

6th Ans. The witness here looked at Exhibits 4, 5 and 6, and says, that she cannot read or write. The Solicitor for the Complainant thereupon, read the said Exhibits to said witness who says, that the land described in said deeds is the Real estate of which William Hill, my husband died, seized and possessed; This real estate is situated in Frederick County Maryland, near the Carroll County line, on Sam's Creek; it contains twelve acres two rods and fifteen perches of land more or less, improved with a dwelling house and out buildings. I do not know the value of it - he paid Four hundred and ninety two dollars (\$492⁰⁰/₁₀₀) for it.

Did said William Hill die intestate or testate?

7th Ans. He left a will.

8th Inter

Did said William Hill leave a widow now living? if yes, give her name, age and place of residence?

8th Ans. I am his widow, and reside in Frederick County Maryland

9th Inter

Did said William Hill leave any children surviving him, and if yes, give their names, ages and places of residence, and if married, give the names of their husbands or wives?

9th Ans. William Hill left two children surviving him both married. George Hill who is married and whose wife's name is Nancy Hill, he resides in Baltimore City Maryland. Nancy Griffin who is married to James Griffin and who also resides in Baltimore City Maryland.

10th Inter

Did said William Hill have any other child or children who are now dead, leaving children? and if yes, give the name or names of such deceased child or children, with the time of their deaths and give the names of their children and also their ages and places of residence? State fully all you know herein.

10th Ans. He had another child named Rebecca Pulley the wife of Pulley unknown to me who is now dead, died about nine years ago. She left two children one of whom is now
