To the end therefore that your Petitioner and the other creditors of Gideon Slifer deceased, may be paid their just claims out of said trust funds, may it please your Honors to pass an order notifying the parties to this Cause to show cause on or before some day certain in said order to be named why your Petitioner and the other creditors of Gideon Slifer deceased should not be paid out of said trust funds as herein prayed.
