To the 1st Inter

1st Ans. I know the parties to this suit and have known them for a number of years

To the 2nd Inter

2nd Ans. I know the defendants Emily and Mary Howell. They are infants under 21 years of age and reside in the City of Philadelphia in the State of Pennsylvania

To the 3rd Inter

3rd Ans. I know the defendants Maria Brock widow of Jonathan Brock and Emily L Howell widow of John Howell. The former is aged about 60 or 65 years of age and the latter is about 40 years of age.

To the 4th Inter

4th Ans. I am acquainted with said property I look at Exhibit No 1. now shown me and said Exhibit does describe the same.

To the 5th Inter

5th Ans. The said property can not be divided among the parties interested without loss or injury and I think that it would be to the interest of all the parties concerned in it that it should be sold and the proceeds divided among them. The reasons for my answer are these: that the property originally belonged to the New London Copper Mining Company which failed and this property was bought at Sheriff's sale by Simon Pocy in his own name; but for the benefit of some of the Original Stockholders in the said Company Pocy subsequently conveyed this property to the parties entitled in the proportions to money furnished by them were of unequal amounts and consequently the property which consists of only about thirty acres with mining rights is entirely incapable of being divided among those interested in it according to their respective proportions.
