Memorandum of an agreement made by the Board of County School Commissioners of Frederick County to purchase one acre or less of land for the purpose of a Public School house Site in Liberty Election District No 8, of the widow and children of Levi Ecker late of Frederick County, decd. The said Board of County School Commissioners agrees to buy of the parties aforesaid for the purpose aforesaid one acre of land or less at the rate of \$100 per acre and to pay costs of proceeding necessary to obtain good legal title for the same. Said site to be located at the intersection of the public road leading from Liberty town to New Market with the public road leading from the Frederick and Liberty Turnpike Road at the 1st toll gate West of Liberty to the said Liberty and New Market Road. The said School Board to have the right to purchase a full square acre of said land bounded by said Public Roads on two sides with the other two sides parallel therewith
