2. Do you know the parties to this suit? If yea, which of them and how long have you known them?
3. State whether or not any of the parties to this suit are infants under twenty one years of age? If yea who are they and where do they reside?
4. State whether or not the said George Levi Ecker, Albert W. Ecker, Thomas C. Ecker, Carrie Belle Ecker, Clarence J. Ecker, Ella Eugenia Ecker, Ida May Ecker and Cordelia E. Ecker are seized and possessed of any real Estate in Frederick County. If yea, State how they are so seized and possessed and whether Mary E. Ecker has any interest therein and if so what?
5. Look at Exhibit No 1. Now shown you and State whether or not the land described therein is part of the Real Estate of which said parties are so seized and possessed as tenants in Common?
6. State whether any liens are on said land described in Exhibit No 1, and if yea what are they?
7. State whether or not it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties to this suit, infants as well as adults, to have one acre or less of the land described in "Exhibit No 1" (the location and description of which one acre or less is now read you) sold to the Board of County School Commissioners of Frederick County for the purposes and upon the Consideration mentioned in the Bill and to have the proceeds applied in part payment of the mortgage held by George W.
