Fisher her husband who reside in Baltimore City commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day in said writ named to answer the premises and to show cause if any they have why a decree should not pass as prayed

It is thereupon this twentieth day of April Eighteen hundred and Eighty two adjudged ordered and decreed by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity, that the foregoing inquisition be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed and that Thomas H. Fisher of Baltimore City be and he is hereby appointed a Committee to take charge and custody of the person and estate of the said Harrietta Elizabeth Farr and it is further ordered that before he proceeds to take charge and custody of her said estate and property, he shall give bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of Ten thousand dollars for the faithful discharge of his trust herein and it is further ordered that he make reports to this Court once in every two years of his proceedings in the premises
