

No. 4663 Equity

The Bill further charges and represents that on the thirtieth day of January A.D. 1881 the said Barbara Green departed this life, that the said Francis Green at no time had a grand child by the name of Caroline Holmes, and that so much of said last will and testament as devises the fee of said real estate to his grand child Caroline Holmes must fail because there is no person and over was of that description to take said fee

The Bill further represents that the said Francis Green left surviving him the following named children and heirs at law, being sons and daughters, to wit: The Complainant Washington Green married to Martha Ann his wife, Elias Green, married to Sarah his wife, Jacob Green Christian Green, married to Susan his wife, Ezra Green married whose wife's Christian name is unknown to these complainants, Adam Green married to Martha Jane his wife and Caroline Holmes married to Horatio Holmes, that the said Adam Green since that died intestate leaving as his only heir Francis F. Green who is a minor under twenty one years of age, that all of said parties reside in Frederick County, Maryland, excepting Ezra Green and his wife, who reside in the State of Indiana, that all are adults excepting Francis F. Green

The Bill further represents and charges that the real estate of which the said Francis Green died seized and possessed and described in the Exhibit to the said Bill, located in and now vests in as tenants in common, the said Washington Green, Elias Green, Jacob Green Christian Green, Ezra Green Caroline Holmes and Francis F. Green and, and that as such they are seized of the same.

The Bill further charges that said real estate is not susceptible of division among said parties without great loss and damage, and that it would be to the interest of all of said parties and especially the infant Francis F. Green to have the same sold under the direction and decree of this Honorable Court, and the proceeds of said sale divided among those entitled to the same

The Bill then prays for a sale of the said real estate under a decree of the Court, for subpoenas against the resident defendants, and an order of publication against the above mentioned non residents

It is therefore, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of July A.D. 1881 adjudged and ordered, that the complainants by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks before the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1881, give notice to the non resident and absent defendants Ezra Green and Green his wife whose Christian name is unknown to the complainants, of the object and substance of this bill and warn them to appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December next: to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed
