To 4th Inter. He died leaving a will and possessed of the property described in Exhibit No. 1. I look at Exhibit No. 2. That is a copy of the will of said Francis Green.

To 5th Inter. The said Francis left a widow and children and children of deceased children surviving him. His widow was named Barbara Green. He left a son Elias Green a daughter Caroline Holmes, a son Jacob Green, a son Christian Green, He left a grand son Thomas J. Green who was a son of Adam Green who was a son of said Francis Green who died before the said Francis Green. He also left a son Ezra Green and a son Washington Green (deponent). They are of age except said Francis J. Green who is an infant under twenty one years of age.

To 6th Inter. The widow Barbara Green is dead, she died about January 29th 1881.

To 7th Inter. The said parties all reside in Frederick County Maryland except Christian Green who resides in Washington County Maryland and Ezra Green who resides together with his wife in the State of Indiana.

To 8th Inter. Some of said parties are married as follows: Elias Green is married and the name of his wife is Sarah Green, Christian Green is married and the name of his wife is Susan Green, Jacob Green is not married to best of my knowledge and belief. Ezra Green is married, but I don't know the name of his wife, Washington Green is married and the name of his wife is Mountha Ann Green, Caroline Green is married and the name of her husband is Horatio Holmes.

To 9th Inter. The said property is not susceptible of division among the parties interested and it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties infant and adults to sell the property and divide the proceeds among them.

To 10th Inter. My reasons are that it is too small to be divided without a sacrifice. The property will go down as no one lives there, and it has already gone down in value and repair.

To 11th Inter. He left no other heirs at law than the children and grand child whom I have named.

To 12th Inter. He did not leave a grand child surviving him named Caroline Holmes. He never had a grand child of that name.

To 13th Inter. His daughter Caroline Holmes his children whose names are as follows Mary L. Holmes, Margaret A. Holmes, Sarah A. Holmes and Seligman Holmes. He had a daughter who is dead but her name was Vandelia Holmes.

Mountha A. Green a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the complainant being duly sworn and examined on the Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Complainants and herewith returned deposes and says

To 1st Inter. I know the parties to this suit and have known them for a number of years.

To 2nd Inter. I look at Exhibit No. 1. I know the property therein described. It is in Catoctin district Frederick County Maryland. It is worth about one hundred and fifty or two hundred dollars.

To 3rd Inter. I knew Francis Green. He was my father in law. He is dead. He died in the Fall of A.D. 1872. Three weeks before Christmas of said year in Frederick County Maryland.
