To 6th Int: The widow Barbara Green is dead. She died about January 29th 1881

To 7th Int: The said parties all reside in Frederick County Maryland except Christian Green who resides in Washington County Maryland and Ezra Green who resides in the State of Indiana

To 8th Int: Some of the said parties are married. Elias Green is married and the name of his wife is Sarah Green, Christian Green is married and the name of his wife is Susan Green, Jacob Green is not married in my belief. Ezra Green is married but I don't know the name of his wife, Washington Green is married to deponent, Caroline Green is married and the name of her husband is Horatio Holmes.

To 9th Int: The said property is not susceptible of division among the parties interested and it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties infant and adults to sell the property and divide the proceeds among them.

To 10th Int: My reasons for this opinion are that it is too small to be divided without a sacrifice. The property will go down as no one lives there to take care of it, and it has already gone down in value and repairs.

To 11th Int: He left no other heirs at law than the children and grand children whom I have named.

To 12th Int: He did not leave surviving him a grand child named Caroline Holmes. He never had a grand child of that name

To 13th Int: His daughter Caroline Holmes his children whose names are as follows: Mary L. Holmes, Margaret A. Holmes, Sarah A. Holmes and Tilghman Holmes. She also had a daughter who is dead, but her name was Van Alia Holmes

There being no other witnesses present to be examined and neither party being desirous of further time for the production of their evidence, the Commissioner closed the Commission and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal this 5th day of January, 1882
