At the request of Ephraim W. Gilbert the following Deed was recorded May 24 1853.

This Deed made this fifth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and Seventy five by Elias Blickenstaff and Elizabeth Blickenstaff his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland witnesses that in Consideration of Six hundred dollars the said Elias Blickenstaff and wife do grant unto Ephraim W. Gilbert of the County and State aforesaid all that Lot or parcel of Land situated in Frederick County the same being parts of several Original tracts of Land Viz: part of the Six Daughters part of Yosts Triangle, part & part of Yosts claim Enlarged

Beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of the 2^d line of Hezekiah Palmers Deed from Jonathan Stottmyer for part of a tract of Land called the Six Daughters and running thence N 46° E 48 1/4 ps then S 17° E 23 ps, S 2 1/2 W 32 1/4 ps to intersect the given line of a tract of Land called Yosts Triangle then N 56 1/2 W 15 1/2 ps then N 46 1/2 W 31 ps to the place of beginning containing 8 1/2 acres of Land more or less.
