To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:

Your orator George W Rowe of Frederick County who sues, as well for himself as all other creditors of Charles J Rowe late of Frederick County deceased who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit, complaining, says:

1. That Charles J Rowe late of Frederick County deceased was in his lifetime indebted unto your orator in the sum of Five hundred Dollars upon a certain promissory note dated the fifth day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty two payable one year after date at five per centum per annum as by your orator's Exhibit No 1 filed as part of this bill will more fully appear
2. That said Charles J Rowe in his lifetime being seized and possessed of Real Estate situated in Frederick County and also of Personal Estate died intestate in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty three.
3. That administration of all and singular the Personal Estate of the said Charles J Rowe hath been lately granted by the Orphans Court of Frederick County unto E. Cora Rowe, his widow of said County; who in virtue thereof has possessed herself of the Personal Estate of the said intestate as will appear from an exemplification of the said letters of administration filed as part of this bill and marked Exhibit No 2.
4. That the heirs at law of the said Charles J Rowe deceased are his widow E. Cora Rowe an adult residing in Frederick County and a son Joseph E Rowe an infant residing in Frederick County.
5. That the said Charles J Rowe being indebted as aforesaid unto your orator and also unto divers other persons in large sums of Money departed this life seized and
