In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and notice given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause I Clayton O Heedy one of the regular Examiners of said Court, having fixed Tuesday the fifth day of February A. D. 1884 at my office in Frederick City at the time and place for taking the testimony in this cause and having given due notice thereof to the parties concerned did then and there proceed to take the following testimony to wit:

The Plaintiff filed with the Examiners as Evidence "Exhibits Nos 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 which are herewith returned by said Examiners

Eugene L Rowe a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined viva voce deponeth and says to interrogatories as follows

1st Ans. My name is Eugene L Rowe, my age is 28 years and my residence Emmittsburg Frederick County Maryland.

2nd Ans. I knew Charles J Rowe late of Frederick County. He is now dead. He died in the latter part of the year 1883 in Emmittsburg Frederick County Maryland. He died intestate

3rd Ans. I have seen him write and am acquainted with his handwriting

4th Ans. I look at Exhibit No 1 now shown me and believe the signature "Chas J Rowe" there to be his genuine signature

5th Ans. The heirs at law of the said Charles J Rowe are his widow E. Cora Rowe an adult about twenty five years of age and a son Joseph E Rowe an infant under twenty one years of age both of whom are residents of Frederick County

6th Ans. I look at Exhibit No 3 now shown me and it correctly describes all the Real Estate which the said Charles J Rowe died seized and possessed

7th Ans. The personal Estate of the said Charles J Rowe is not sufficient to discharge all the debts due and owing him at the time of his death

To the general interrogatory required by Rule No 39 of Equity Rules the said witness answers: I know of nothing further Signed Eugene L Rowe.
