The petition of Charles H Hoffman Executor of the Last Will and Testament of William C Hoffman late of Frederick County deceased. Respectfully represents that he has in his possession as part of the assets of the Estate of the said William C Hoffman several promissory notes viz: a note of \$10,000 - due from H C Goebenhorst; and note of \$2600 - due from William F Hoffman; and a note of \$1063.33 due from Jacob Miller and Philip B Munkell, all of which are well secured; and as it would be to the disadvantage of the parties in interest in said estate to dispose of the same - Your petitioner prays your Honorable body to pass an Order directing and empowering him to assign said note of \$2600 - due from William F Hoffman to said William F Hoffman in part payment of his distributive share of said Estate, and to divide the two remaining above named notes among the four other distributees entitled to equal one fifth shares under said will in payment or part payment of said distributive shares, and to assign and convey said portions so divided to the parties so entitled to receive the same
