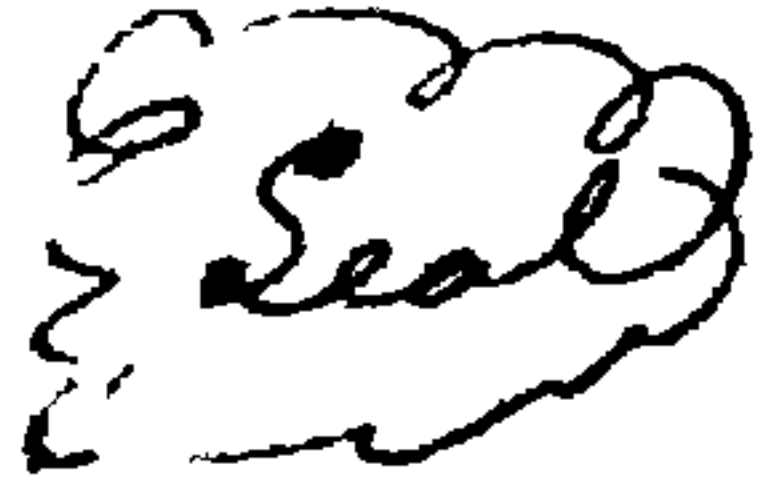

The answer of Leonard A. Haesche, the defendant in the above mentioned Cause to the Bill of Complaint of David C. Martin administrator of the goods and chattels of Anne E. Martin deceased, saith:

This defendant now and at all times reserving unto himself all and all manner of exception to the many errors and imperfections in said Bill of Complaint contained, for answer thereto or to such parts and so much thereof as this defendant is advised it is material and necessary that he should make answer unto, saith:

That this defendant admits the death of Anne E. Martin intestate and the granting of letters of Administration upon her personal estate to the complainant as alleged in said Bill of Complaint; that during the life time of said Anne E. Martin she sold unto this defendant the real estate in said Bill of Complaint mentioned, upon the terms and for the amount specified in the memorandum of Sale exhibited with said Bill of Complaint; that said Anne E. Martin delivered possession of said real estate to this defendant as alleged in said Bill and that this defendant did the work and made the payments set forth in said Bill that parts of said parcel of land so sold to this defendant were, by the permission of this defendant, conveyed by the said vendor to the parties named in said Bill of Complaint as therein alleged

And this defendant further answering saith that he hath paid large sums of money in part of the fraction of said purchase money over and beyond that for which credit hath been given by said complainant in Exhibit No 7 filed with said Bill of Complaint, and this defendant further answering saith that said complainant's intestate improperly applied portions of the money paid to her by this defendant in liquidation of said purchase money towards the payment of taxes on said property without the consent of this defendant.

And this defendant further answering saith that when proper allowance shall be made by said complainant for payments made by his intestate and not credited and when the amount so erroneously applied towards the settlement of taxes shall be
