Say:

1<sup>st</sup> That David Wilhide late of Frederick County died intestate about the year 1870 seized and possessed of a house and lot situated in the village of Mechanics town in said County, and being the same property described in a deed from Frederick White and wife to said David Wilhide, a copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No 1. except so much thereof as was conveyed by said David Wilhide to Elizabeth N Wilhide and James C Mackley by two separate deeds of conveyance copies of which are filed herewith marked Exhibits 2 & 3 respectively, which said Exhibits together with all others herewith filed are prayed to be taken as part of this Bill of Complaint

2. That said David Wilhide left a widow surviving him named Elizabeth Wilhide who has since also died.

3. That said David Wilhide died leaving the following as his only children and heirs at law:

1<sup>st</sup> Alfred Wilhide, a son, who is an adult and resides with his
