2. Ida Harting, a daughter, who is an adult and married to George Harting living in Frederick County
3. George Wilhide, a son, who is an infant and lives in Frederick County
4. John Wilhide, a son, an infant, living in Frederick County
5. Betty Wilhide, a daughter, an infant, living in Frederick County
- 6th. Sully Wilhide, a daughter, an infant in Fredk Co.
7. Jessie Wilhide, a daughter, an infant in Frederick County

5th That since the death of said David Wilhide his said son Elias Wilhide has also died intestate, leaving the following as his widow and only children and heirs at law, viz:

7th That upon the death of said David Wilhide his interest in said real estate descended by inheritance to his said children, and upon the deaths of his said children David L. 8th That all of said parties now own said real estate as tenants in common that it will not admit of advantageous division among them and it would be to the interest of all parties concerned infants as well as adults for said real estate to be sold and the proceeds distributed among them according to their respective interests. Wherefore your Orators pray,

- 1st That said Real estate may be sold by a trustee to be appointed by your Honorable Court and the proceeds distributed among all of said parties in interest according to their respective interests
2. That your orators may have all such other and further relief as the nature of case may require and to your Honors shall seem just.
