Decree

The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill answers Exhibits and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered and all of the defendants who are adults having answered and consented to a sale with the exception of Newton Blessing and Alice Blessing his wife, against whom a decree pro confesso was passed on the 1st day of May A.D. 1884. It is thereupon, this 13th day of August in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty four by the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, as judged ordered and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that Matthew Urner, do and C. V. Lory of Frederick County, be and they hereby appointed Trustees to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of their proceedings shall be as follows: They shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by themselves with a surety, or sureties to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Fourteen hundred dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this
