being duly sworn and examined to interrogatories filed with the Examiners by the counsel for the Plaintiffs and herewith returned deposes and says

To the 1st Interrogatory

1st Ans. I know the adult parties to this suit and know of the infants, but can not distinguish them by names.

To the 2nd Inter

2nd Ans. I know Jacob Trayer late of Frederick County, he is dead, he died in New Market in Frederick some twelve or thirteen years ago.

To the 3rd Inter

3rd Ans. He died testate

To the 4th Inter

4th Ans. I knew Sarah Trayer his widow, who was the executrix of his will, she is dead she died in New Market in Frederick County in the month of June 1854

To the 5th Inter

5th Ans. She died intestate

To the 6th Inter

6th Ans. Jacob Trayer died seized and possessed of real Estate, at the time of his death he had three lots of land two of which together contained about thirteen acres and the other one about four acres. The four acre lot was subsequently sold by Mrs Sarah Trayer the widow and executrix, to Joseph Molesworth. These lots lay near New Market in Frederick Co. She also owned another lot situated in the town of New Market and is what is called a "back lot". The thirteen acres and this back lot are together worth about \$1000. I look at Exhibits Nos 2 and 3 and 4. I suppose they identify and describe said lots but am not able to identify the names of the grantors therein.

To the 7th Inter

7th Ans. He did leave children as follows viz: William H Trayer whose is married to Marietta his wife, Eliza Swomley the wife Daniel Swomley; Thomas C Trayer who is married to a Miss Smith whose Christian name I do not know, Martha F Hammond the wife of Grafton Hammond; Jacob V Trayer married to Virginia his wife; Henrietta P Trayer, who is unmarried; George Milton Trayer who was married but whose name I do not know. Mortimer P Trayer married to Anna, his wife, Susan Emma Trayer who is now the wife of John I Smith and Laura V Trayer now the wife of Oscar P Bellman. These parties are all adults, William H + Thomas C Trayer live in Pennsylv Pennsylvania, Mr and Mrs Bellman live in Washington Co Md, and the rest of the children live in Frederick County except Jacob V and George Milton Trayer who are dead. Jacob V Trayer died in Carroll County in the year 1851 leaving his widow Virginia Trayer and a number of children whose names I do not know. George Milton Trayer died in Philadelphia about ten or twelve years ago and after his father's death, leaving a widow and I believe, one child an infant whose name I do not know.

To the 8th Inter

8th Ans. Sarah Trayer died, seized and possessed of the real Estate, I look at Exhibit No 5 now shown me and believe it describes the same. It is a house and lot in New Market and is worth about \$1000.

To the 9th Inter

9th Ans. she did. The children and heirs at law of Sarah Trayer are the same persons who have been mentioned as the children + heirs at law of Jacob Trayer dec^d

To the 10th Inter

10th Ans. I believe there is a mortgage upon it held by Mrs Anne Molesworth
