At the request of James Hiddle the following Deed is recorded the 16th Nov 16th 1840
This Indenture made this 4th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven by and between John Jones and Sarah Ann Jones his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland of the one part and James Hiddle of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Jones and Sarah Ann his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred & thirty dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said James Hiddle before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said John Jones & Sarah Ann his wife if as hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Hiddle his executors administrators heirs and assigns forever all and singular of a certain piece or parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid being part of a tract of land called the Land of Promise and for the outlines thereof beginning at the end of twenty four perches on the right line of the whole tract called as aforesaid and running with said line North forty nine degrees West thirty three perches to a planted at the end of fifty seven perches on the said right line then South thirty and a half degrees
