That your Petitioner's claim is just and unpaid and should be paid out of the funds now in the hands of the trustee subject to the order of your Honorable Court whereupon your petitioner prays that an order may be passed by your Honorable Court directing said trustee to pay out of said funds in his hands said sum of fifty dollars and fifty five cents in full of his said tax claim and for such further and other relief as he may be entitled to And as in duty bound
