The Petition of Jacob R. Rodrick and the exhibits therewith, in the above entitled cause having been read and considered by the Court, it is therefore this third day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and Eighty five by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity do hereby order and by the authority thereof ordered and adjudged that the said Jacob R. Rodrick be and he is hereby relieved from the execution of the duties of the Trusteeship in said Petition mentioned and it is further ordered and adjudged that Clayton O'Keedy be and he is hereby appointed Trustee in the place of the said Jacob R. Rodrick to perform and carry out the trusts expressed in the deed, a certified copy of which is filed with the Petition in this Cause and the said Clayton O'Keedy is hereby directed to sell the land and premises in said deed and petition mentioned and the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows: He shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland executed by him with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of Fifteen
