Beginning at the North East Corner of said lot and running thence West twenty two feet thence South two hundred and twelve feet six inches thence in a South East only direction twenty five feet seven inches thence in a straight line North two hundred and twenty one feet six inches to the beginning said lot adjoining the property of James Hopwood on the East and the property of Richard C. Waters on the West
