9. Has said Susan of Clay married at the time of her death? and did she leave any heirs at law and if you give their names ages and places of residence and state how they were related to said Susan of Clay?
10. Do you know or can you state any other matter or thing which may be of benefit or advantage to the parties to this cause or either of them, or that may be material to the subject of this your examination or the matters in question between the parties? If you, state the same fully and at large in your answer
