8. And your Orators pray for the following process

(1) A writ of subpoena against the said John S. Rhoads and Elizabeth Rhoads his wife of Frederick County Maryland commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named and to show Cause, if any they have why a decree should not be passed as prayed

(2) And for an order of publication giving notice to William H. Rhoads and Amanda Rhoads both of Washington City in the District of Columbia Benjamin M. Rhoads and Anne E. Rhoads his wife both of the State of Indiana; and Mary A. M. Denny of the State of Illinois non residents of the State of Maryland of the object and substance of this Bill warning them and each of them to appear in this Court either in person or by solicitor on some certain day to be named therein to show Cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed and to abide by and perform such order or decree as may be passed herein

At the request of Lewis Rodrick (v. d. R. Samp #112) the following deed was recorded December 31st 1869.

This Deed made this 16th day of September in the year one thousand Eight hundred and sixty nine by me, Joseph Watten, Witness that in consideration of Seven hundred and twenty five dollars and fifty cents, I the said Joseph Watten do grant in fee simple unto Lewis Rodrick the following described piece or parcel of land lying and being in Frederick County in the State of Maryland it being a part of a tract of land called "The Second Resurvey on Suckette's Ferry Maryland" and being more particularly a part of that part of said Resurvey which was about the year 1838 surveyed by Horace C. CNeal for 219 1/4 acres as Gloyd Suckette's part of said tract which was subsequently conveyed to the said Joseph Watten.

Exhibit A

Beginning for the part thereof hereby intended to be conveyed at a stone formerly planted at the end of 27 perches on the 5th line of the whole tract called "The Second Resurvey on Suckette's Ferry Maryland" it being also the end of the 2nd line of said Deed to Joseph Watten and running thence with the 5th line thereof correcting the same for Variation South 88 degrees West 62 perches to a rock in the public road leading from Hammonds Hill to the Catonsville branch then with said South 55 1/4 degrees East 25 64/100 perches to a stake planted on the North side of said road South 35 degrees East 28 64/100 perches to a stake planted near the South side of said road South 47 degrees East 12 perches to a stake planted then crossing the public road leading to Jefferson South 63 1/4 degrees East 4 perches intersecting the 2nd line of Joseph Watten's deed aforesaid then with said 2nd line correcting the same as aforesaid North 13 1/4 degrees East 51 perches to the first mentioned place of beginning containing nine acres and eleven square perches of land And the said Joseph Watten doth further Covenant that he will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed
