

No 5016 Equity

Land, consisting of about 9 acres and 11 perches, situated in Frederick County and which is described in the Exhibit filed with the Bill; that he departed this life intestate, in Frederick County in the year 1880; that he left surviving him a widow who died in the year 1888 and that he left the persons named in the title of his order of publication as his children and only heirs at law all of whom are yet living and to whom the said real estate descended. That all of said parties are adults over the age of twenty one years and that all of them are residents of Frederick County Maryland except the Plaintiff Jacob R. Rodenick and Esther Anne his wife who reside in Loudoun County Virginia and the defendants William W. Rodenick and Amanda his wife who reside in Washington City in the District of Columbia and Benjamin M. Rodenick and Anne E. his wife who are residents of the State of Illinois and Mary A. Mc Ginnery who is a resident of the State of Indiana

The Bill further states that the said real estate cannot be divided among the parties interested without great loss and injury and prays for a decree for the sale thereof and a distribution of the proceeds among the heirs and for general relief. It also prays for subpoenas against the resident defendants and an order of publication against the defendants who are non residents of the State of Maryland

It is therefore this 6th day of October A.D. 1884 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity adjudged and ordered that the Plaintiff by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks prior to the 8th day of November A.D. 1884 give notice to the said William W. Rodenick and Amanda Rodenick his wife; Benjamin M. Rodenick and Anne E. Rodenick and Mary A. Mc Ginnery, the non resident defendants of the object and substance of this bill and warn them and each of them to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 18th day of February A.D. 1885 to show cause if any they have why a decree should not be passed as prayed
