of any real estate? If you, describe the same and state where it is situated?Look at Exhibits Nos 1 & 2 now shown you, and state whether they describe any  
portions of the same?6<sup>th</sup> Int. Give the value of said real estate?7<sup>th</sup> Int. Did the said Jacob Kline leave a widow surviving him? If you, give  
Interrogatories her name age and residence?8<sup>th</sup> Int. Did the said Jacob Kline leave surviving him any children, grand-  
children or other heirs at law? If you state their names ages and residences  
and if any are married give the same facts of their husbands or wives as the  
case maybe?9<sup>th</sup> Int. You have stated in your last answer that Amy C Kline, a daughter  
of said Jacob, died since her father, now state when and where she died; whether  
she died testate or intestate and whether she left any personal estate?10<sup>th</sup> Int. State whether or not the said Jacob Kline was indebted to the Plaintiff  
at the time of his death? If so on what account? Look at Exhibit A now shown  
you and state whether it contains a true and just statement of said indebted-  
ness and whether the same has ever been paid?11<sup>th</sup> Int. State whether or not the said Amy C Kline was indebted to the Plaintiff  
at the time of her death? If so on what account? Look at Exhibit B now shown  
you and state if it contains a true and just statement of said indebtedness  
and whether the same has ever been paid?12<sup>th</sup> Int. State whether or not said real estate is susceptible of division among  
the parties interested, without loss and injury, after so much thereof is sold  
as is necessary to pay the debts of said Jacob and Amy C Kline and the expenses
