This Deed made this thirteenth day of May in the year of Our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seventy nine by Alexander Ridemour and Susan Ridemour his wife of Washington County in the State of Maryland Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars the said Alexander Ridemour and Susan Ridemour his wife doth grant unto of Hiram Kline of Frederick County in the State aforesaid, all the one eighth undivided portion of the three following named and described parcels of land of which Jacob Kline of the father of the said Susan late of Frederick County did seized said lands lying and being situated in Catoctin District of Frederick County Lot No 1 being the same land that was conveyed by Jacob Senebaugh to the said Jacob Kline by deed dated 4th day of April 1839 and recorded in Liber J.S. No 31 folios 263 & one of the Land Records of Frederick County. Beginning for said parcel at a Stone standing at the end of the West thirty perch line of a tract of land called "The Third Time of Asking" of which this is a part, and running thence with the outlines of said land two corners North 8° West 30 perches to a Stone, West 42 perches to a Stone then South 23 1/4° East 62 perches to a Stone standing 2 perches from the beginning tree of a tract of land called "Mountain Vacancy" then North 36° East 36 perches to the place of beginning containing ten acres and thirty six perches of land more or less. Lot No 2 being the land that was conveyed by Jacob Kline sen to the said Jacob Kline by deed dated 20th May 1834 and recorded in Liber J.S. No 47 folios 236 & 237 one of the Land Records of Frederick County. It being parts of two several tracts of land Mountain Vacancy and "Third Time of Asking" Beginning at a bounding white oak tree the beginning of tree of said tract of land called "Mountain Vacancy" and running thence North 86° East 78 perches to a Stone planted North 47° West 36 perches to a Stone, West 30 perches to a Stone South 36° West 36 perches to a Stone then by a straight line to the beginning containing 9 1/2 acres of land more or less

Lot No 3 being the land that was conveyed by Jacob Williams and Catherine
