At the request of Henry A Hinea the following Assignment is recorded Sept 11. 1878  
This Assignment made on this 11 day of September A.D. 1878 by one John F D Miller of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witness the Morris A, the the said John F D Miller and indebted unto Henry A Hinea in the full and just sum of Two hundred and thirty one dollars and twenty eight Cents and whereas it is my desire to secure the payment of the same now therefore in consideration of the promises and one dollar in hand paid to the said John F D Miller do hereby assign to the said Henry A Hinea all my right title and interest as a legatee or devisee under the will of John W Miller my father Executed on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1875 and now recorded in the Register of Wills Office of Frederick County and as one of his heirs in his estate - It is further understood that on the settlement of said estate if there is anything left out of any share after paying the above sum of two hundred and thirty one dollars and twenty eight Cents and interest on the same from date it is to be paid over to the said John F D Miller
