Decree

This cause being submitted by agreement filed in the cause for decision the petition, answer, depositions and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is thereupon this tenth day of November A. D. 1884 by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity and by the authority thereof adjudged, ordered and decreed that the right title, interest and estate of Margaret J Ramsburg, Alexander H Ramsburg, John E Ramsburg and Sarah H Ramsburg the infant defendants in this case and that of each of them in the lands and real estate mentioned in the proceedings in this cause together with the right title, interest and estate of Margaret J Ramsburg and of Newton A Ramsburg therein, they having filed their consent thereto be conveyed by way of Mortgage for the purpose of raising the sum of two thousand dollars with which to pay the mortgage lien now existing upon said real estate and for this purpose Robert M Ramsburg is hereby appointed trustee to make, execute, and deliver the mortgage hereby decreed to be made, for the sum of Two thousand dollars with interest from date the principal payable three years after date and the interest payable semi annually to such person as may loan said sum his personal representatives or assigns, said mortgage to be made in the usual form and containing a power of Sale in the usual form, and the said trustee is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate said two thousand dollars thus raised by said mortgage to the payment of the mortgage now existing on said real estate and to make report of his proceedings under this decree to this Court under oath
