I give and devise unto my nephew C. Keeper Thomas all of
my right title and interest whatsoever in and to the tract or parcel of land situate and
lying in Buckeys town District in Frederick County Maryland known as the Home
Farm containing about three hundred acres of land, to him the said C. Keeper
Thomas his heirs and assigns, subject however to the payment annually of one
hundred dollars to Nottley W Thomas, during the period of his Nottley W Thomas
natural life

Extract from the last will and Testament of Samuel S Thomas late of Frederick
County Md. deceased as recorded in Liber G. M. E. No 1 folio 318 One of the Record
Books of Wills in the Office of the Register of Wills of Frederick County

I give and bequeath to my only son Samuel Thomas four
hundred acres of land, to be laid off on the East Side of the whole tract, on which he
and myself now both reside, containing together about seven hundred acres, more or less
and in such a manner that a due proportion of Wood shall be attached to each part, and as
convenient to water as may be (and I also give to my said son Samuel the seven following
negroes, all Slaves for life (to wit) Abingo, Abraham, Cassy, Emmeline, Barney, Philip,
and George likewise my saddle horse two cows, and a good feather bed complete all
the above property both real and personal. I give to my said son Samuel Thomas his
heirs and assigns forever-

I give and bequeath to my three single daughters (to wit) Eliza, Phoebe and Mary
all the remaining part of that tract of land of which I have given my son Samuel four
