Gavor to Jeremiah A Gavor, to Charles B Gavor to Joseph W Gavor and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my three sons O. J. Gavor and Charles B Gavor, and Joseph W Gavor to be my Executors of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me heretofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament.

Codicil
