He was seized and possessed of Real Estate situated in Frederick County Maryland at the time of his death, it consists of a farm of about 124 acres of land situated in Jacksons District in this County, and also of three mountain lots also in Frederick County, the witness here looks at Exhibits Number 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6, and says the said Exhibits described said real estate except the Exhibit No 3, which describes a portion of land sold to David Hinner by said Joseph Gavor and wife in his life time, the entire unencumbered value of the farm is about \$7400⁰⁰ in my judgment and the mountain land the three lots are worth about \$200⁰⁰

7th Ans. He left seven children surviving him as follows:

1st a son George W Gavor, married to Susan Gavor his wife, both of whom reside in Frederick County

2nd a daughter Jane R married to James H Michael both of whom reside in Washington County

3rd a daughter, Malinda C, married to Albert J Fiery both of whom reside in Washington County

4th a son Otto Gavor married to Kate Gavor his wife both of whom reside in Frederick County

5th a son Charles B Gavor who is unmarried and resides in Frederick County

6th a son Joseph W Gavor the present witness who is unmarried and who resides in Frederick County and

7th a son Jeremiah R Gavor who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland and whether married or not I do not know, but when last heard from lived in Montana territory he left home about four years ago, we heard from him at intervals up to about two years ago, since which time we have received no word from him and do not know his whereabouts.

All of which said seven children are adults over twenty one years of age All these seven children are the same persons, named as devisees or legatees in the last will and testament of said Joseph Gavor deceased.

He left some Personal estate, it is not sufficient to pay all his just debts, Some one of the Executors and the Personal property is worth about \$2000⁰⁰ and the claims against his estate amounts to about \$8000⁰⁰ and in addition there are about \$3600⁰⁰ filed against the estate on which he is surety, The Personal estate is largely insufficient to pay all of the claims

10th Ans. He executed a mortgage to secure his sealed note given to Margaret C Schaefer of Frederick County, for the sum of \$2200⁰⁰ the principal of which is wholly unpaid and interest thereon due from Sept 9th 1884
