great loss and damage and that it would be to the interest and advantage of all the above named parties to have the same sold and the proceeds divided among them according to their respective interests. The Bill then prays for a sale of the said real estate under a decree of this Court, that the proceeds may be divided among the plaintiffs and defendants according to their several interests, that the plaintiffs may have such other relief as their case may require for subpoenas against the resident defendants and an order of publication against the above mentioned non resident defendants.

It is therefore this 15th day of November A.D. 1853 adjudged and ordered, that the plaintiffs by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks before the 22nd day of December A.D. 1853 give notice to the non resident and absent defendants Sarah Jacobs, John G. Jacobs and Catharine his wife Jonathan Baker, Henry Jacobs and Jacobs his wife whose Christian name is unknown Jacob A Jacobs and Jacobs his wife whose Christian name is unknown Susan Harkman and Sampson Harkman her husband, Benjamin F Jacobs and Jacobs his wife whose Christian name is unknown, William D F Jacobs and Jacobs his wife whose Christian name is unknown of the object and substance of this Bill and warn them to appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before the 23rd day of March A.D. 1854 to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to pass as prayed.
