To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court, Your Orators, and
 Oratrices complaining

1. That a certain John Derr, senior, being possessed, of a large
 estate real, and personal, made his last Will, and testament
 bearing date December fourteenth A.D. 1829, in manner, and form
 sufficient to pass real estate, as will appear by a certified copy
 thereof herewith filed, and marked Exhibit A, and which is
 prayed to be taken as a part hereof as fully as if herein at large
 in words, and figures set forth.

2. That thereafter said John Derr Senior died, without having
 altered or changed said will.

3. That in and by said Will he devised to his daughter
 Catharine Reese, during her life-time, a farm, situate in
 Frederick County and described in said Will, and further devised
 said farm to her issue, if she left any and after failure of
 issue, then to the other children and their desc. of said
 John Derr Sr. except his son John, as will fully appear
 by said will.

4. That said John Derr left surviving him, the following children
 a son John, a daughter, Elizabeth Getzendanner, a daughter
 Mary or Polly Getzendanner and the said daughter Catharine Reese.

5. That the said Catharine Reese has just departed this life, without
 leaving any issue, and without having a husband surviving her.

6. That upon the death said farm descended to the descendants of
 the said other children of said John, Senior, except this said son
 John.

7. That the said Elizabeth Getzendanner, daughter of said John Derr
 Senior, departed this life some time ago, leaving the following children
 and descendants of deceased children, to wit, a daughter
 Mary Dechter, who is married to John Dechter, a daughter
 Catherine Lighter, who is married to Henry Lighter, a son Thomas
 E. Getzendanner whose wife — Getzendanner, Charlotta Getzen-
 danner the widow of a deceased son John D. Getzendanner, John
 St. Getzendanner (whose wife's name is Malisa Getzendanner) a son
 of said John D. Getzendanner, deceased; Annie E. Getzendanner
 the widow of Samuel P. Getzendanner, now deceased who was a
 son of said John D. Getzendanner, deceased, and Edith Regina
