The joint and several answer of John A. Getzendanner and Margaret Getzendanner his wife to the Bill of Complaint of Edward T. Getzendanner and others against them and others in this Court exhibited.

1st. These respondents for answer admit that John Derr Sr. died seized and possessed of a large estate, real and personal, that he left a last Will and Testament dated December 14th. A.D. 1829, that the said Real estate is fully described in said Will, and is situated in Frederick County and State of Maryland, as is set forth in said Bill.
