6th. Int. Did the said John Derr Sr. die seized and possessed of any Real property, if yea, describe the same, state its value, location and quantity. Look at paper writing marked Exhibit A "B" "C" & "D" here with shown you and state whether or not the said Exhibit fully describe the Real property of which the said John Derr Sr. died seized and possessed.
