To the 1st Intv.

1st Answer. My name is Harrison Miller, my age 64 years, my residence Frederick County, and I am a retired farmer.

To the 2d. Intv.

2d. Ans. I know all the parties to this suit and have known them for some years.

To the 3d. Intv.

3d. Ans. I did not know him.

To the 4th. Intv.

4th. Ans. I believe he did from what I have heard.

To the 5th. Intv.

5th. Ans. I look at it. I believe that to be a certified copy of said last will and testament. I have heard of that will for a good many years. He never altered or changed it, that I ever heard of.

To the 6th. Intv.

6th. Ans. He died seized and possessed of a large quantity of real estate situated in Frederick County. I look at Exhibits A, B, C and D, and believe they do describe the same.

To the 7th. Intv.

7th. Ans. He left a widow. She is dead; She died in Frederick County about the year 1852.

To the 8th. Intv.
