James E. Stamp, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiff being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories herewith returned, deposes and says:

To the 1st. Ques.

1st. Ans. My name is James E. Stamp, my age 44 years, and I reside in Frederick City.

To the 2d. Ques.

2d. Ans. I know all the parties to this cause. They all live in Frederick County except Dr. Justus Dunott who lives in Cecil County, and Isaac Lowenstein who lives in Washington County Maryland.

To the 3d. Ques.

3d. Ans. I was acquainted with her; she is dead; she died in Frederick City in the fall of 1884 and she left no will. She left a husband, who has since died.

To the 4th. Ques.

4. Ans. She left the following children, as her heirs at law, viz: - George C. Derr, whose wife's name is Francis Charles E. Derr, whose wife's name is Alice R. Millard, Helen whose wife's name is Mary. Hiram A. Derr whose wife's name is Florence Margaret J. McLane, married to Rufus A. McLane, Elizabeth Engelbrecht, married to George Engelbrecht and John L. Derr. These parties are all over twenty one years of age, and reside in Frederick County.

5th. Ans. She did, seized and possessed of real estate situated in Frederick City - Md. It is worth about \$2800. I look at Exhibit No. 1 and that correctly described the same.

To the 6th. Ques.

6th. Ans. It could not be divided among the parties without loss and injury and it would be to the interest of them all to have the same sold, and the proceeds divided; because the property is going down and their real live claims on some of the interests which if sold out will impair the value of the rest of property.

To the Gen. Ques. by the Examiner.

Ans. I know of nothing further.
