I Mary A. Schleigh of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Considering the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby to be better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say.

First = I give and devise to my Daughters Lucretia S. Street, and Ellen A. Chipley, to be equally divided between them, one set of China ware.

Second = I give and devise to my Son Frederick W. Schleigh, one Desk.

Third = After the payment of my debts and funeral expenses, It is my Will and I direct, that what may be left of my Estate shall be divided into five equal parts, One fifth to my Daughter Lucretia Street, One fifth to my Daughter Ellen A. Chipley, One fifth to my Son Lawrence Beck, One fifth to my Son Frederick W. Schleigh, and one fifth to my Grand children of my deceased Daughter Mary C. Heard, that may be living at the time of my death, to be equally divided between them, when they arrive at lawful age.

And lastly, I hereby nominate, and appoint, Thomas C. Pope, Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and also Guardian of my Grand children, Children of my deceased Daughter Mary C. Heard.
