This Deed made this nineteenth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty eight, by Edward Shriver and Elizabeth L. Shriver his wife, of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. It witnesseth, that in consideration of four hundred and ninety dollars, the said Edward Shriver and Elizabeth L. Shriver his wife do grant unto Mary Ann Schleigh of the county and State aforesaid that lot of ground lying on Beaver Alley in Frederick Town, and known as the Ice house lot, where in are erected, a stone ice house, and a brick stable, the lot hereby conveyed fronting on Beaver Alley sixty two feet more or less and running back to Howard's lot thirty one feet more or less and being the same lot heretofore conveyed to the said Edward Shriver by Grayson Eichelberger, Justice of George D. Fisher by deed dated the tenth day of October A. D. 1855, and recorded in Liber E. S. No. 8 folio 46 & 47 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, as by reference thereto will more fully and largely appear.
