To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity.

In this case I have charged the Trustee with the first or cost payment; I have then allowed him the usual Chancery Commission taxed costs and expenses of sale, State and County taxes. I then allowed the widow one-tenth in lieu of dower and distributed the residue to the twelve children of the deceased as per instructions.
