- (3) A son, Parker B. Grosnickle, whose wife's name is Mary, both of whom are adults and residents of Frederick County, Maryland.
- (4) A son (one of your orators) Cyrus L. Grosnickle whose wife's name is Sarah, both of whom are adults and residents of Frederick County.
- (5) A son (one of your orators) Benton E. Grosnickle whose wife's name is Clara F., both of whom are adults and residents of Frederick County.
- (6) A son, Titghman L. Grosnickle, who is an unmarried adult and a resident of Frederick County.
- (7) A daughter, Sarah E. Grosnickle who is an unmarried adult and resides in Frederick County.
- (8) A daughter, Lauretta A. Baumgardner, who is married to Marshall Baumgardner, both of whom are ^{and residents} adults of Frederick County, and.
- (9) A daughter, Media B. Grosnickle who is an infant, about fourteen years of age and a resident of Frederick County.

IV. That said Real Estate will not admit of being divided among the parties without great loss and injury to the parties interested.

V That it will be for the benefit and advantage of all the parties interested, infant as well as adults to have said Real Estate sold and the proceeds divided among them in proportion to their respective interests.

To the end therefore

1. That said Real Estate may be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds divided among those entitled and.
2. That your orators may have such other and further relief as their case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your orators the following process.

1. The writ of Subpoena directed to the said Ellen E. Grosnickle, widow; Parker B. Grosnickle and Mary Grosnickle, his wife; Sarah E. Grosnickle; Lauretta A. Baumgardner and Marshall Baumgardner, his husband, adults; and Media B. Grosnickle, an infant, all residents of Frederick County commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some day certain to be named therein to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such order or decree as may be passed therein; and
2. An order of Publication against the aforesaid Enelope Haugh and Addison Haugh her husband both of Franklin County in the State of Pennsylvania and Clara Haugh and Henry Haugh, her husband, both of Seneca County in the State of Ohio giving notice of the object and substance of this Bill and warning them and each of them to be and appear in this Court in person or by Solicitor on or before some day to be therein named to show cause if any they or any of them have why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
