6. State the Value of said Real Estate?
7. State whether or not said Real Estate is susceptible of partition or division among the said children and heirs at law of Daniel Grofenickel, without loss or injury, thereto? If not, state your reasons for your answer?
8. State whether or not it would be for the benefit and advantage of all parties, infant as well as adult, to have said Real Estate sold, and the Proceeds divided amongst them, and give your reasons for your answer?
