Robt Johnson, and after his Death, to pay and distribute the Funds so invested, and any other part constituting the Trust Funds, in his hands, as Trustee, as aforesaid, among the children of the said Robt Johnson, including under the term "Children, the child, or children of any of his children, who may then be dead to be divided per stirpes -

It is my Will and intent, in creation the Trusts herein before declared, for the benefit, of the respective wives and children of my said Nephews, Northington R. Johnson, Richard P. Johnson and Robt. Johnson, that their respective wives, or children, or some of them shall keep house, during the lifetime of my said respective Nephews, and that the Trustee of the funds herein before Willed, and bequeathed, for the use of the said respective wives and children, of my said Nephews, Northington R. Johnson, Richard P. Johnson, and Robt. Johnson, shall permit their said wives, or their said respective children, who may live with their parents, and keep house, to occupy the property, the Real Estate, or if rented to receive the rents thereof, or in case the said Trust funds shall be invested in Public, or Private securities, the said trustee shall pay the interest, or income accruing thereupon, from time to time, as it may be received, to the respective wives of my said Nephews, Northington R. Johnson, Richard P. Johnson, and Robt. Johnson, or to such of the respective children of my said Nephews who shall keep house, as hereinbefore directed, during the lifetime of each of my said Nephews, and the receipts of the said respective wives of my said respective Nephews, or the receipts of their said children, who shall live with their parents, during the life time of my said respective Nephews, and keep house, shall be a full discharge of such payments, of said interests and incomes, accruing from the invested funds, during the lifetime of my said respective Nephews.

And lastly, I constitute, and appoint, my Brother George W. Potts, and my Brother-in-law Richard P. Marshall, to be executors of this my last Will, and Testament, vesting in them, or the Survivor of them, full power to execute, this my last Will, and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills, by me made.
