Your Honorable Court passed an order directing said Trustee to make sale of certain Stocks, Bonds and other investments belonging to said Trustee's Estate, and Report his action to this Court for its further order. That in pursuance of the order of your Honorable Court, said Trustee sold said Bonds, Stocks, and choses in action, and received as the net proceeds of the sale of the same, the sum of Ten thousand Eight hundred and sixty Eight dollars and forty Eight cents. And that sum be invested in Six Ground rents of Eighteen hundred dollars each, or property situated in the City of Baltimore and bearing interest at the rate of Five per cent or Ninety Dollars per Annum each, and which said change of Investment was ratified and approved by order of Your Honorable Court, passed Jan'y 24th 1883, which, together with the expenses attending the same, made an investment of ten thousand eight hundred and forty five Dollars and five Cents as will appear by reference to a Statement of the same, which is filed marked Exhibit A, which said Trustee prays to gether with other exhibits herewith filed, may be taken and considered as part of this his Report - And said Trustee further reports that the investments held by him at this time and forming the Trust Estate, are fully set forth and described in a statement herewith filed marked Exhibit B, and said Trustee further reports that the Gross amount of Income received by him from the same rents held by him and belonging to said Trust Estate from the time the same came into his possession, up and until the date of the Death of Rosa Johnson amounted to the sum of 443.62 as appears by the statement showing the amounts received and the date thereof marked Exhibit C. And that during the same period he paid to his Vestigee, Trustee under the Premises of the Will of said Eleanor Potts thereof \$425.62 as appears by the Statement herewith exhibited marked Exhibit D. And said Trustee further reports that Rosa Johnson, the Nephew of said Eleanor M. Potts and during whose life by the terms of said Will, said Trust was limited, departed this life on the Nineteenth day of January, in the Year Eighteen Hundred and Eighty three, and that he left surviving him the following named children, Mary P. Johnson, Washington Johnson, Eleanor M. Johnson, Nathan A. Johnson, Richard P. Johnson, Maria H. Johnson, Harriette M. Johnson, Rosa Johnson, and Jane Keall Johnson. To whom by the terms of said Will, the said Trust Estate, after the death of the said Rosa Johnson, said Trustee was directed to pay and distribute the funds invested and any other part constituting the Trust funds in his hands, That all of said children are of full and lawful age to receive their distributive share of said Trust Estate, except Harriette M. Johnson, Rosa Johnson, and Jane Keall Johnson who are infants - Your Petitioner further alleges that for the purpose of making the distribution of the Trust estate aforesaid among the parties entitled thereto, that it will be necessary sell and dispose of the investments hereinbefore set out and that it would be to the interest and advantage
