7. That the said Widow Catharine Reese hath lately, ^{having died} died in November A. D. 1884.

Reese being heirs of the said John Reese named in said Will and the said Elizabeth Hoy, Rebecca Masel, Mary Ann Zimmerman being heirs of the said Catharine Mertz named in said Will.
