Forrest, Trustee of Solomon Forrest late of Frederick County deceased, Witnesseth, that whereas by a Decree of Circuit Court of said County, sitting as a Court of Equity, the said Daniel W. Forrest was authorized to sell the Real Estate of said deceased and his sold part of the same to George W. W. Hurley of Fredk Co. Md. for the sum of Eight hundred and ninety-six $\frac{2}{3}$ dollars, who has fully paid the purchase money therefor, Now therefore in consideration of the foregoing premises, the said Daniel W. Forrest doth grant unto the said Geo. W. W.
